

3. **The terms and conditions of the tender would be as follows:**

- a) Application to purchase of vehicle shall be submitted by hand or by courier / post in the prescribed format only, in a sealed envelope marked "QUOTE FOR CAR".
- b) Application not submitted in the prescribed format, are liable for rejection.
- c) Rates for the items for disposal should be given in both the figures and words, any overwriting or erasing the figures shall not be considered for acceptance of the rates offered by the tenderer.
- d) The bids are invited for the lot (i.e. the vehicle is considered as a whole and no bid would be accepted for any part of the same). The items shall be sold to the highest bidder.
- e) Duly completed documents shall be submitted to our office at the address given above on or before 30th July 2018 by 1500 hrs.
- f) The bid must reach on above said address on prescribed time or before the due date and time. Bid received after the due date and time, due to any reason whatsoever, shall not be considered.
- g) A Bid shall be treated as successful only after the competent authority in the Consulate General of India, Sydney has approved it in accordance with the terms of the Tender Notice. Consulate General of India shall send the notice of acceptance to the successful highest Bidder.
- h) The Consulate General of India, Sydney reserves the right to accept or reject any/all bids without assigning any reason whatsoever at any stage.
- i) The decision of the Consulate General of India, Sydney is final and binding.
- j) The highest bidder is required to pay full amount of the bid/negotiated amount immediately on accepting the offer, by way of cash or bank cheque made favourable to the Consulate General of India, Sydney.
- k) It is the responsibility of the successful bidder for arranging transfer of ownership of the vehicle purchased in the records at his/her cost.
- l) The new owner will be required to arrange by himself all the formalities of the vehicle for example new number plate, REGO, CTP or Any other insurance, Pink Slip or Blue Slip etc.
- m) The successful bidder will be required to remove the vehicle from the disposal site within three (3) days after the deposit of payment. The successful bidder, at his own cost, will also be required to make his own arrangement of transport, labour etc. for removing of sold vehicle.
- n) The ex-number plate will remain the property of the Consulate General of India, Sydney.
- o) No item once sold to the successful bidder shall be taken back by this Post on any condition whatsoever.
- p) The vehicle will be sold on "as is where is basis" and no guarantee for its worthiness or quality will be given by the Consulate.
