The High Commission of India, Canberra is pleased to announce that the High Commission and our Consulates in Sydney, Melbourne and Perth will start accepting applications from eligible Indian nationals for re-issuance of their International Driving Permit with effect from 15th February 2021.

2. The process will involve the following steps:

Applicant will submit the Miscellaneous Consular Service form to the VFS Centre (either by post or by visiting the VFS Centre). The fees for this service will be AUD 16 plus ICWF charges (AUD 3) along with VFS Service Charges, as applicable.

Following documents will be required from the applicant for this service:

- (i) Misc. Consular Service Form.
- (ii) Current Valid Passport in original.
- (iii) Expired/expiring IDP of the applicant in original.
- (iv) Current valid Indian domestic driving license in original.
- 3. On the submission of the above documents, Mission/Consulate will issue a receipt to the applicant. Thereafter, the applicant will have to visit the portal www.parivahan.gov.in and upload the documents along with the receipt issued by the Mission/Post. On receipt of application through the portal, the licensing authority, on verification of the documents, shall issue the IDP and shall courier it directly to the address of the applicant.
